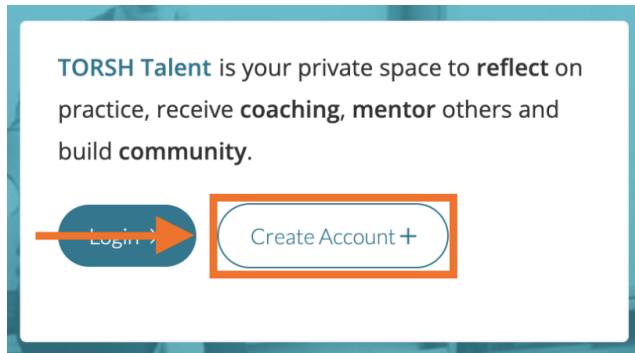





TA Collections

Technical Assistance Modules grouped by topics such as “Transition,” “Outcomes,” “IFSP Services,” and “DEC Recommended Practices,” etc.

TA Modules are short, self-paced lessons to build skills for carrying out common Part C Program processes

Completion of TA Modules result in ongoing professional development hours

FC PATHS: “Available PD” – Modules by Topic

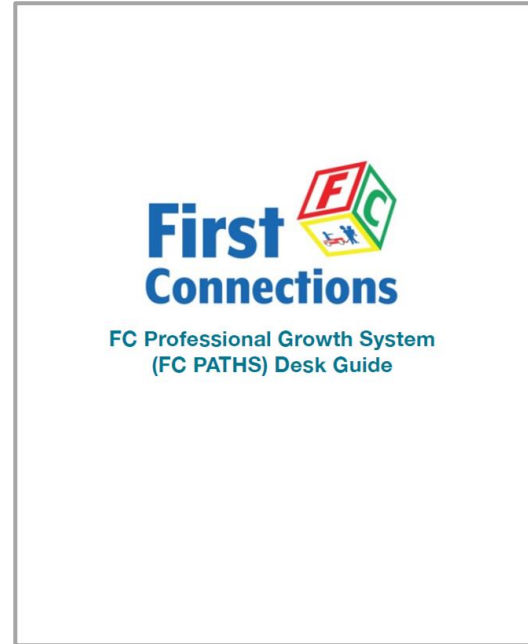
